PROGRAM MANAGER

YOUR DAY: You make camp run! You schedule, coordinate, coach and supervise our staff. You communicate with campers and do what it takes to make their experience exceptional. You respond if something goes wrong and uphold the values and vision of camp!

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$510-525 (Assistant Program Manager) to \$550-\$600 (Program Manager)

YOUR DATES: Mid-May through late August or early September

YOUR STRENGTHS: Leadership - Creativity - Communication - Customer Service - Calmness

WHY YOU MATTER: You are the leaders of our summer team. Your hard work creates life-changing experiences for the staff and campers who come through our gates.



PROGRAM LEADERS

YOUR DAY: You will have a specialty area like Nature, Arts & Crafts, Lifeguarding, Tot Lot (childcare) or the Camp Store. For half of the day, you will facilitate that part of the camp experience. For the other part of your day, you will help plan, facilitate and supervise the wide array of camp's recreation activities such as staffing the swimming hole or hosting the camp talent show. You'll also do whatever it takes to keep camp moving, from preparing the site, responding to guest needs and cleaning up!

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$440-480/week + bonus pay for lifeguards

YOUR DATES: Thursday, June 3 - Sunday, August 8 (flexible)

YOUR STRENGTHS: Teamwork - Friendliness - Customer Service - Enthusiasm - Safety

WHY YOU MATTER: You're the camp memory makers AND you make camp run! Whether exploring nature for the first time or challenging family members in a raucous game of tug-of-war, you build connections with campers and help them bond with each other.



FOOD SERVICE STAFF

YOUR DAY: You will work alongside a team to prepare nutritious and nourishing meals for our staff and guests. We feed groups of 150-300 at a time! Your team will include kitchen directors, cooks and dishwashers.

YOUR PAY: \$1,040/week for leadership positions; \$560/week or \$14/hour for dishwasher and kitchen helpers

YOUR DATES: Flexible start dates in May/June through early-August

YOUR STRENGTHS: Safety - Health - Teamwork - Positive Attitude

SPECIAL NOTES: Specialty pay may be available for staff with experience in vegan cooking, and some food service leaders will have the opportunity to work through September 7!

WHY YOU MATTER: Youth and Families at Feather River Camp slow down and bond over shared meals--within their own family groups and with other members of the community. You create the environment where these connections and bonds are made.

HOUSEKEEPING STAFF



YOUR DAY: You are responsible for the day-to-day cleanliness of camp. From preparing a tent or cabin for a family's arrival to emptying our trash and recycling cans around camp or keeping our bathrooms safe and clean, you complete a variety of tasks across the site.

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$560-\$600/week (or \$14-\$15/hour)

YOUR DATES: Late April to mid-September

YOUR STRENGTHS: Physical Strength - Positive Attitude - Attention to Detail - Able to Work Independently

SPECIAL NOTES: Housekeeping staff must be able to lift 50 pounds and be on their feet most of the day.

WHY YOU MATTER: When campers arrive, we want them to feel that this is their home for the week. You make sure camp is a pleasant and safe place to live.



BUILDING + GROUNDS STAFF

YOUR DAY: You work with the facilities manager to make sure the physical parts of camp are running smoothly. From plumbing to carpentry or electric work, you respond when something goes wrong and you do continuing maintenance to prevent future problems.

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$800-\$1,100/week or \$20-25/hour

YOUR DATES: Mid-April to late September

YOUR STRENGTHS: Physical Strength - Positive Attitude - Technical Skills - Able to Work Independently

SPECIAL NOTES: Building and grounds staff must be able to lift 50 pounds and be on their feet most of the day.

WHY YOU MATTER: We want our facilities to be as beautiful as our natural environment. You help make camp a safe and comfortable home for our campers so they can enjoy the fun and community of our program!

STORE COORDINATOR



YOUR DAY: You work to keep the camp store organized and clean. You manage inventory and account for purchases. You interact with campers as they visit the store and you spend some time assisting in the camp office.


YOUR STARTING PAY: \$600/week or \$15/hour

YOUR DATES: Mid-May to mid-August

YOUR STRENGTHS: Organization - Customer Service - Sales - Trustworthiness - Leadership

SPECIAL NOTES: This position requires a candidate with a high level of professionalism! Bonus points for previous retail or management experience.

WHY YOU MATTER: Campers enjoy shopping in our camp store and it is one of the most important ways we earn revenue to sustain our non-profit program. Your leadership serves the campers while they are at camp and helps keep our program going!



OFFICE MANAGER

YOUR DAY: You keep everything going behind the scenes. From answering phones to reconciling payments or orienting new guests to camp, your multi-tasking gets the job done!

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$800-\$1,120/week or \$20-28/hour

YOUR DATES: Late May to Mid-August

YOUR STRENGTHS: Organization - Customer Service - Flexibility - Attention to Detail

WHY YOU MATTER: We want to make the logistics of the camp experience as easy as possible on our families! You go above and beyond to make sure everything is handled appropriately so that campers can fully enjoy camp.



HEALTH SUPERVISOR

YOUR DAY: Depending on the program being offered, your responsibilities vary. During Family Camp, you act as a resource for the adults and children at camp. During Youth Camp, you administer medications, perform first aid, and conduct health evaluations. You also respond to emergencies.

YOUR STARTING PAY: \$1,040-\$1,200/week

YOUR DATES: Early June to mid-August

YOUR STRENGTHS: Problem Solving - Organization - Compassion - Listening - Trustworthiness

SPECIAL NOTES: Some certifications are required, such as CPR. We can help you achieve certification!

WHY YOU MATTER: You help keep campers and staff healthy at camp! You are there for people when they are sick or injured. You make people feel secure and safe.
