Facilities Department

The Facilities Team handles the behind-the-scenes work that keeps camp functional. They manage repairs, plumbing, electrical systems, cabin/tent upkeep, trail and grounds maintenance, cleaning, trash and recycling, and emergency response support. This team works closely with all departments to turn spaces over quickly and maintain safety standards.

Food Service Department

The Food Service Team keeps camp fed - three meals a day, plus BBQ events and special dietary needs. This is one of the biggest operational teams onsite. They're responsible for food prep, service, dishwashing, cleaning the Chow Palace, and maintaining health and safety standards. This team works fast and tight, especially on high-volume days.

Lead Cook

You're the kitchen's anchor: coordinating prep, leading the cooking team, and making sure every dish that leaves the Chow Palace is safe, timely, and top quality. If you thrive under pressure, love high-volume cooking, and take pride in heading up a kitchen team, this is your role.

Lead Cook - Specialty Diets

You're the culinary ace who leads meal planning and execution for guests with food allergies, who are gluten-free, vegan, and other dietary needs - while also supporting the kitchen team. If you're detail-oriented, skilled in creative kitchen work, and passionate about inclusive dining, this role is for you.

Cook

You're in the kitchen action, prepping, cooking, and plating for a big crew while keeping things safe and delicious. If you love creating, moving fast, and seeing smiles at the dinner table, this spot is for you.

Lead Kitchen Helper & Dishwasher

You're the crew leader who keeps the dish team running smoothly, guiding others while keeping the kitchen and dining spaces spotless and on schedule. If you're organized, steady under pressure, and ready to lead by example, this is your spot.
